Kent County beaches are open to the general public, operating under “LIFEGUARDS NOT ON DUTY – SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.”

If applicable, limited restroom facilities are
“USE AT YOUR OWN RISK OF CONTRACTING COVID-19.”

The following restrictions remain in place until further notice:

NO GRILLS/GRILLING

NO TABLES

NO TENTS

Patrons **MUST PRACTICE SOCIAL/PHYSICAL DISTANCING** by keeping distance between oneself and others and avoiding crowds.

County Government employees/park personnel have full authority on the beach, grounds and parking areas.
