Early School Dismissal & On Time School Dismissal KCPR After School & Evening Program/Activity Cancellation Communication Policy

Schools Dismiss Early: After School & Evening Programs Closed

If KCPS, or an individual school, closes earlier than the normal dismissal time for any reason, including inclement weather, <u>KCPR will not make individual phone calls to</u> <u>parents/guardians of children participating in Parks and Recreation programs held</u> <u>at schools</u>. Parents/guardians are aware through KCPS policy that when there is the threat of inclement weather it is their responsibility to tune in to the appropriate television stations, radio stations, and KCPS website for announcements. KCPR program participant parents/guardians are aware that when KCPS close school early, all KCPR programs at schools are closed.

Schools Dismiss on Time: After School & Evening Programs Closed

If any or all KCPS close at the normal dismissal time but cancel afterschool and evening programs for any reason (including weather related), <u>KCPR will alert</u> <u>parents/guardians via our Rainout Line Weather/Cancellation and Updates</u> <u>Notification Alert Method. KCPR will not make individual contact to parents/guardians of children in Parks and Recreation's after school and evening programs held at schools.

KCPR will request that announcements are made at schools that all Parks and Recreation programs and activities held at schools and the Community Center are closed.
